

Mah Jongg



Mah Jongg is a tile-based game that was developed in the 19th century in China and has spread throughout the world since the early 20th century. It is commonly played by four players but can be adapted to three if necessary.

The game is played with a set of 144 tiles with each player beginning with 13 tiles. In turn, players draw and discard tiles until they complete a legal hand based on the annual card distributed through the National Mah Jongg League.

Classes are available for new players.
