Primary Care Clinic

The UF Health Senior Primary Care Clinic is open to Members for non-emergency medical needs. The Clinic is operated as a UF Health Senior Care Clinic and is dedicated to Oak Hammock.

Services are provided by a Nurse Practitioner (APRN) and Physicians. Members can see the APRN without an appointment by signing in at the Clinic Reception Desk. Members may also call (352) 548-1100 to reserve a time that same day to see the APRN.

Nurse Practitioner services include some of the following:

- Colds, cough, sore throat
- Bumps, bruises
- Falls
- Ear cleanings
- Blood pressure checks
- B-12 injections
- Stitch/staple removal

- Medication refills for established patients in practice
- INR checks (coumadin/warfarin management)
- UTIs
- Flu vaccines
- Referrals

After-hours health care needs for Members being followed by UF Health Senior Care should call the Senior Care on-call service at (352) 265-0615 and a physician will respond as soon as possible. Other Members should obtain this information from their individual physicians.

Flu Vaccine – The seasonal Flu Vaccine is offered at the Primary Care Clinic. Call the Clinic Receptionist to schedule your appointment to get the FLUZONE HIGH DOZE Flu Vaccine.

Oak Hammock Advantage

This is a special service for Members of Oak Hammock designed to facilitate scheduling appointments with any doctor or clinic affiliated with Shands at the University of Florida. You must first Pre-register and establish or confirm your personal electronic medical record number (known as EPIC patient number). The EPIC patient number is used to coordinate your care through the UFHealth/Shands network and tags your medical record as belonging to an Oak Hammock Resident. This notifies Oak Hammock's GatorMed Concierge of your admittance to or your presence in the UFHealth Emergency Department.

Provides one direct phone number to schedule the earliest available medical appointments regardless of specialty.

Provides an opportunity to request an available private room at any UFHealth hospital provided medical condition severity has been first considered.

Contact Oak Hammock IL Social Worker (352) 548-1162 to confirm your registration into the Oak Hammock Advantage Program. Any clerk with access to EPIC within the UFHealth Physicians network can verify your Oak Hammock Advantage membership.
